103: COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

- I. Purpose:
 - a. The Board of Directors may appoint standing committees as deemed necessary for the effective governing of the school.
- II. Policy Statement:
 - a. The Standing Committees of the Board of Directors shall be appointed by the President of the Board following the annual reorganization of the Board. Term of office for Standing Committees shall be one year. The President shall designate the Chairman of each committee. Standing Committees shall report to the Board of Directors at a regular meeting of the Board.
 - b. Committees may be created by the Board for specific assignments. When so created, such committees shall be appointed by the President. Such committees shall terminate upon completion of their assignments, or such committees may terminate by a majority vote of the Board. The Head of School and the Principal shall be considered non-voting members of each committee.
- III. Responsibility:
 - a. It is the responsibility of the President of the Board to appoint the Standing Committees of the Board of Directors and designate the Chairmen of each committee.
