a. Head of School

Good start to new school year. Thursday meet and greet (parking lot and overflow was packed). Professionalism was evident. 3 teachers resigned. One leave of absence and one moved within. Charter renewal is due September 30th.

Maintenance did an outstanding job of readying the grounds and facilities for the new year. All playgrounds have new rubber mulch which is a lifetime change. Changes being made to the beginning of the driveway including a speed bump and stop sign. Dining hall is becoming Farm to School. The goal is to have prepackaged food phased out by January.

b. Principal's Report

Scheduling has been completed. 427 classes entered into E-School. 90 minute blocks in Math and Reading. RTI 30 minutes for K-1 and 45 minutes for 2-8th grade. Current Enrollment is 689, which is 40.12 units.

Accountability student verification report. 75 students no longer at PCA were showing up in the DOE as PCA students. Teachers had 3 days of professional development.

c. Financial

No local district money. Added more categories to budget to make for better expense tracking. Buses cost \$286,000. Will be paid off this year. After this year this money will be going into savings. CBOC will receive petty cash copies of check records from now on. Committee's next meeting September 17th.

d. Curriculum

Scholastic Reading and Math Inventory to take place of Star Testing. Ready Common Core, Math and Writing will be used for grades 2-5. Grades 1 and 2 will have print handwriting and Grades 3-5 will have cursive.

World Cultures will be incorporating basic languages of continents, cultures and their geography. This is an attempt to raise geography scores across the school. September 22nd book launch by author David Teague "Connect the Stars".
