Revenue:

- 96.87% of the revenue has been received as of February 28, 2019.
- An IV was generated for Capital School District to pay their portion of the Unique Alternatives. A line item was added for these funds. We are still waiting on payment.
- There was no change in the local district carry over which is now \$295,401.44.

Expenditures:

- Current expenditures are at 65.19% overall which is below the 66.7% of the year by 1.51%. Last month we exceeded the budget projection by 1.23%.
- We continue to trend high in contracted services which are at 72.44% and 73.11% funds expended.
- There was an increase in the interest received from the state. The year to date interest is \$19,146. Last month we received \$6,032. Jen and Brandon are looking into the reason for the change.
