PCA Citizens Budget Oversight Committee Meeting Minutes January 21st, 2021

Meeting was conducted through a phone conference

Revenue:

- The school has received 81.61% of expected revenue as of December 2020.
- As part of the mid-year budget review, the revenue budget was reduced from \$7,910,731.15 to \$7,768,1121.38.
- Special Funds was decreased to \$20,000 from \$126,044.80 due to cancelations during COVID.
- Local Interest Income was increased to \$53,817.96 from \$35,740.50 based on the current rates.
- Transportation was reduced to \$725,234.

Expenditures:

- PCA is 50% into the school year and overall expenditures are at 46.56% which is 3.44% under the actual percentage for this month. Last month's expenses were at 41.7% which was 4.5% under the actual percentage.
- As part of the mid-year review, the following categories were adjusted to align with current expenditures:

Salaries: \$3,255,513 to \$3,092,587

Other Employment Costs: \$1,720,277 to 1,653,331

o Contracted Services: \$1,225,91 to \$1,179,608

Supplies and Materials: \$403,372 to \$358,602

Departments: \$946,660 to \$1,127,281

Capital Improvements: \$102,217 to \$54,543

- Overall expenditures were decreased from \$7,824,296.37 to \$7,663,492.82. Based on planned expenditures, the budget shows a surplus of \$104,619.56.
